- 4. Subcommittee B, C and D Discussions and Recommendations
 - Committee Members from Subcommittee B, Subcommittee C, and Subcommittee D presented their Subcommittee Recommendations. The Committee as a whole discussed these recommendations.
 - Main Points of Discussion:
 - Chair *Johnathan Li* questioned the decrease in benefit rates for Chicano Student Programs' Priority 1: Graduate Researcher. Last year the benefit rates were 28% and this year the benefit rates are 3.17%. *Cathy Eckman* clarified that benefit rates changed this year which resulted in the drop from 28% to 3.17% for the Graduate Researcher.
 - Cathy Eckman discussed the possibility of having Counseling & Psychological Services' Priority 1: Protocall – After Hours Phone Service funded by Student Mental Health Fees. As a whole, the Committee agrees to direct funds from the Student Mental Health Fees to fund Counseling & Psychological Services' Priority 1: Protocall. Therefore, the Committee agrees to not fund the priority using Student Fees, but rather Student Mental Health Fees.
